
to recruit the countdown to the end of recruitment has now well and truly begun!

**Important Notice** 



Please take extra care to ensure that during randomisation the woman's parity has been entered correctly. We are aware of some inconsistencies between the response given to 'Is the woman nulliparous?' and the previous pregnancies recorded on the Baseline Medical Data form. Parity is a minimisation criteria therefore it is very important this data is accurate during randomisation to ensure equal balance between groups.



#### Misoprostol administration

Please remember that women should only be issued with 1 x 800mcg dose of misoprostol on day 2. Women should only be issued with further misoprostol doses, if required, after day 2 post-randomisation. Please ensure that all EPU staff at your site are aware of this requirement in order to prevent women being issued within multiple doses on day 2
