# Birmingham Foundation Academy Priorsfield Award Scheme

## **Terms & Conditions**

## 1. Definitions

- 1.1 "Academic Year" means the University's year of academic study.
- 1.2 "Award" means the Priorsfield Award for Students of the BFA.
- 1.3 "BFA" means the University of Birmingham Foundation Academy.
- 1.4 "Fees" means the fees payable by the Student for tuition at the University.
- 1.5 "Student" means a student registered at the University for study at the BFA.
- 1.6 "The University" means the University of Birmingham, Edgbaston, Birmingham B15 2TT.

### 2. Award

2.1 Whenever the University agrees to make an Award to a Student these terms and conditions shall apply unless otherwise expressly excluded in whole or in part. The Award is only valid for one Academic Year.

## 3. Eligibility

- 3.1 Students who are sponsored in full for their Fees are not eligible for an Award.
- 3.2 All other Students of the BFA are eligible to receive an Award provided that their written acceptance of an offer to study at the BFA is received by the University by no later than 10<sup>th</sup> July 2012.
- 3.3 For the avoidance of doubt the Award is applicable to Students for their first year of registration at the University only and is not applicable to Fees payable in any subsequent Academic Years.

# 4. Payment

4.1 Payment of the Award shall be made by way of a reduction in the Fees payable by the Student in the sum of £1,000.

4.2 The University reserves the right to demand repayment of all or part of the Award in the event the Student has failed to pay the balance of the Fees or has failed to make arrangements for such payment acceptable to the University.

#### 5. Termination

- 5.1 The University reserves the right to demand the repayment of all or part of the Award made towards the Student's Fees during the Academic Year in the circumstances set out below:
  - 5.1.1 the Student leaves the University voluntarily during the Academic Year
  - 5.1.2 the Student is required to withdraw from the University pursuant to disciplinary proceedings.

#### 6. Miscellaneous

- 6.1 Any dispute or complaint arising in connection with the Scheme should in the first instance be addressed in writing to the Director of Student Services.
- 6.2 These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and any dispute arising out of the operation of this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
