



## MBChB Admissions Cycle: 2023-24

### 5-Year Medicine Programme (A100):

There were no adjustments made to the admissions scoring algorithm for Home applicants from that used in the previous year's admissions cycle.

Number of places (2024 entry):

Home –372

International – 28, of which 6 are reserved for applicants from IMU-Malaysia entering the Clinical Years of the programme.

### Interview selection process:

1. **Home** – Primary mechanism for selecting those for interview (other factors are relevant):

- a. Ranking by application score (45% GCSE: 40% UCAT and 15% contextual score).

## MBChB Admissions Cycle: 2021-22

### 5-Year Medicine Programme (A100):

For Home applicants, we substantially altered our algorithm for calculating an application score last year, therefore historical data from previous years is not directly comparable to admissions from 2020-21 onwards.

For the 2021-22 application cycle, we have made further amendments to this scoring algorithm and past data should be used with great caution when making a judgment about the likelihood of success of a future application.

Number of places (2022 entry): Home –342; International – 28

### Interview selection process:

1. Home – Primary mechanism for selecting those for interview (other factors are relevant): ranking by application score (45% GCSE: 35% UCAT and 20% contextual score).

##### Interview selection process:

This is the third year that we will calculate an application score and rank applicants by this score in order to determine who we will invite to interview (though other factors are relevant). The parameters contributing to the score are: degree result; A Level grades; UCAT score; time in FT employment/PG study.

Threshold: 15.56 (maximum = 20), with minimum UCAT score of 2800

## MBChB Admissions Cycle: 2020-21

### 5-Year Medicine Programme (A100):

It is very important to note that for the standard 5-year undergraduate programme (A100) we substantially altered our algorithm for calculating an application score in 2020 (for 2021 entry). Therefore historical data from previous years is not directly comparable to admissions from 2020-21 onwards and should be used with great caution when making a judgment about the likelihood of success of a future application.

Number of places (2021 entry): Home – 340 (i.e. 332 plus 8 extra places for one year only to account for additional deferrals from 2020 entry); International – 28

### Interview selection process:

1. Home – Primary mechanism for selecting those for interview (other factors are relevant): ranking by application score (45% GCSE: 30% UCAT and 25% contextual score).
