# **Medici: The Enterprise Training Programme**

Medici is the University of Birmingham's flagship training programme designed for research staff currently exploring the commercial potential of their research.

The Medici programme will give you the business skills, knowledge, and confidence you need to engage with business and industry in an impactful and professional way.

The programme is aimed at research staff interested in developing the impact of their research be that through creating new inventions, therapies, treatments, and medical devices, providing expert consultancy, licensing a technology, collaboration with business, spinning out a company, developing a service or delivery of CPD training etc.

#### **Dates**

The programme consists of 7 days of face-to-face training delivered by the University of Birmingham, on the following dates:

- Wednesday 22 and Thursday 23 January 2025
- Wednesday 12 and Thursday 13 February 2025
- Wednesday 12 and Thursday 13 March 2025
- Wednesday 2 April 2025

Potential delegates may be at a very early stage with no clear commercial offering, or they may already be working on a viable project.

### **Course Content**

The course will give you an understanding of the routes available for the exploitation of university research and will help you to recognise the key stages in the development of your idea.
